

## **URGENT MAJOR PUBLIC MEETING**

Restore Our Water International (ROWI) is holding a major public meeting to update the community about what can be done about our unprecedented low water levels in Lakes Michigan/Huron/Georgian Bay. This is having huge negative impacts environmentally, ecologically, socially and economically.
