Fire Pumps

We have 5 cottagers or groups of cottagers who have expressed interest in obtaining a fire pump kit for their cottage or their group of cottages. We have explored suppliers and presently have narrowed it down to 2 possibilities.

One Stop Fire Products is well known in this department. They are the company that can always be found at the Cottage Life Show. They specialize in Wickman pumps starting with a Wick 80-4H(4stroke) beginning at approximately \$2000 for the entire kit and range up to a Wickman 100 RTF two stroke high pressure pump for \$3400.

The other option is Georgian Bay Small Engines in Parry Sound who deal in Honda pumps. Their kits start at approximately \$1500.

Prices can vary depending on how much hose you require. One Stop quoted 150 feet while GBSE quoted 200 feet.
