

TRAVEL TO AND FROM WINDSOR, ONTARIO

Windsor is easily accessible by plane, train, bus or car.

PLANE:

1. Air Canada is the only airline serving Windsor, with frequent daily flights. Most Canadian conference participants from outside Ontario will connect at Toronto to a flight from Toronto to Windsor. Alternatively, there is airbus (van) service to Windsor (4 hours away).

2. For those using Westjet, the closest destination is London, Ontario. There is airbus service to Windsor (2 hours away).

Robert Q Airbus has service to Windsor from Toronto or London or Detroit many times daily. One can book directly on the web or call them at 519-673-6804. They have a toll free line from Canada or the US at 1-800-265-4948. One should reserve a space in advance and ask about the drop-off location.

U.S convention participants will find it more convenient to use Detroit Metropolitan Airport. Robert Q Airbus can provide connections to Windsor.

TRAIN:

VIA Rail serves all cities along the Quebec City/Windsor corridor including Quebec City, Montreal, Kingston, Toronto, London.

BUS:

Bus travel is an option to the train, but with more links. Windsor has a new Greyhound Bus Terminal station downtown close to major hotels.

CAR:

From points east in Ontario: Take Highway 401 directly to Windsor.

Windsor is readily accessible from London (2 hours), Toronto (4 hours), Hamilton (4 hours), Ottawa (9 hours), Montreal (10 hours). It is also easily accessible from:

1. Michigan: Detroit (5 minutes), Ann Arbor (1 hour), East Lansing (2 hours),
2. Ohio: Toledo (1 hour), Cleveland (3.5 hours), Columbus (4 hours), Cincinnati (5 hours),
3. Illinois: Chicago (5 hours),
4. Indiana: South Bend (4 hours).
