

Liberal and Professional Studies – University of Windsor

Our Liberal and Professional Studies program links courses in several disciplines including business, arts, social sciences, science and engineering. Students can combine course concentrations in such diverse fields as computer science, business, visual arts, and communication studies, making this program appealing to anyone who wants to maintain as many options as possible. The courses are offered on-campus and/or through distance education or partial distance education.

Another advantage is that part-time students who are working full-time should always be able to find a course to take at a convenient time.

The Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences is the right choice for students who want a traditional, liberal arts education, as well as for those who want cutting-edge programs which reflect the needs of our changing world.

Program Requirements (30 courses)

Total courses: 30, at least 16 of which must be at the 200 level or above, and at least six of which must be at the 300 level or above. Students may take no more than six courses in any single subject area (as defined by prefix numbers, e.g., 46–115 (except in the case of Engineering). Other requirements:

- six courses from Arts and Languages
- six courses from Social Sciences
- four courses from Science or Engineering*
- four courses from Business Administration

*Courses 85-118, 85-130, 85-131, 87-325 are available to non-Engineering students:

Students in the Liberal and Professional Studies program must maintain a cumulative average of 5.0 or better. There is no major average requirement.
